If they are damaged, you could have difficulty seeing the road in front of you, which could be a sign of extensive internal damage. Your brakes might not work properly, or the engine could overheat, making it unsafe to continue driving. If even just one wheel alignment could be off after a collision, and could cause your vehicle.
